### Conditions of Sale

- 1. Produce will only be accepted for sale if you have entered the honey competition for the category of product you wish to sell.** So, to sell honey, enter at least one honey class in Classes 1-18: Wax, at least one wax class in Classes 19-25 and so on. Entry for one class in another category will not mean that honey can be brought for sale. **There will be no exceptions to this rule.** In consequence, vendors will receive 100% of the sale prices set. Product liability remains with the producer.
- 2. All honey, comb and wax must be labelled strictly in accordance with current regulations. Note that honey labels must reflect THE HONEY (ENGLAND) REGULATIONS 2015.** All items for sale must be accompanied by 2 copies of the Sales Entry Form plus 2 copies of the itemised list and must be brought to the Honey Show between 4.30 and 5.30PM on Friday, 6 October or before 9.30 AM on Saturday, 7 October 2017. Unless prior agreement has been made, or alternative methods of delivery agreed, no items will be accepted for sale other than at these times. The Honey Sales manager's decision is final.
- 3. Items sold by variable weights (e.g. cut comb sections etc.) must bear a label showing the weight in grams and the selling price on every item. Please round up to the nearest 10p.** These items must be accompanied by two copies of a completed itemised form.
- 4. Honey must be packed in crates or sturdy boxes.** For ease of handling by sales stewards, each box should contain a maximum of 20 454gm jars or produce of equivalent weight.
- 5. Each box or crate must be labelled on the side with the Surname of the owner in letter at least 25mm high.**
- 6. The Honey Show Sales manager and the Honey Show manager or their deputies reserves the right to reject any item not complying with these conditions of sale. Their decision is final.**
- 7. Hampshire Beekeepers Stewards will use their best endeavours to ensure the security of displayed, unsold stock and cash but HBA cannot accept responsibility for theft, breakage or other loss.** In the event of any discrepancy after the closing stocktake at the end of the sale, this will be apportioned across all producers in proportion to the value of sales.
- 8. Goods from each producer will be displayed with equal prominence and sales stewards are not permitted to "push" or "withhold" any particular produce.** Any steward so doing, will be replaced.
- 9. Producers must make arrangements to collect all unsold stocks after 4.30pm on 8 October.** Producers will not be permitted to touch their unsold produce until the Honey Show Sales manager has done a full stock take, together with the Honey Show manager (or his deputy) and accounted for all sales. There may be a delay before this is completed and producers may have to wait before they will be allowed to collect their unsold produce. Given that Competition exhibits cannot be removed until the same time, this should not be a major issue.
